



Lake Norman Driving Academy would like to congratulate you on successfully completing your behind-the-wheel portion of driver education.

I want to remind parents that all students under the age of 18 must get an ***Eligibility Certificate*** from their child's high school before going to the DMV for the Learner's Permit test. A Parent/Guardian (only) can obtain this certificate. The parent ***must*** bring the ***Certificate of Completion*** to their child's high school to prove that the student has completed their driver education requirement. The school will then check the student's grades, and issue the *Eligibility Certificate*.

If you have any questions regarding this certificate, you should contact the Student Services or Guidance Office at your child's high school.

See below the **4** documents needed to take the Permit Test:

**Documents required for North Carolina Learner's Permit testing:**

1. *Original Birth Certificate*
2. *Original Social Security Card*
3. *Certificate of Completion (obtained from Lake Norman Driving Academy)*
4. *Eligibility Certificate (obtained from the student's high school)*

**Please Note:** Driver's Eligibility Certificates expire (30) days after the date they are issued.

Remember to study the DMV Handbook. All test questions are taken from the DMV Handbook.
